Project Overview



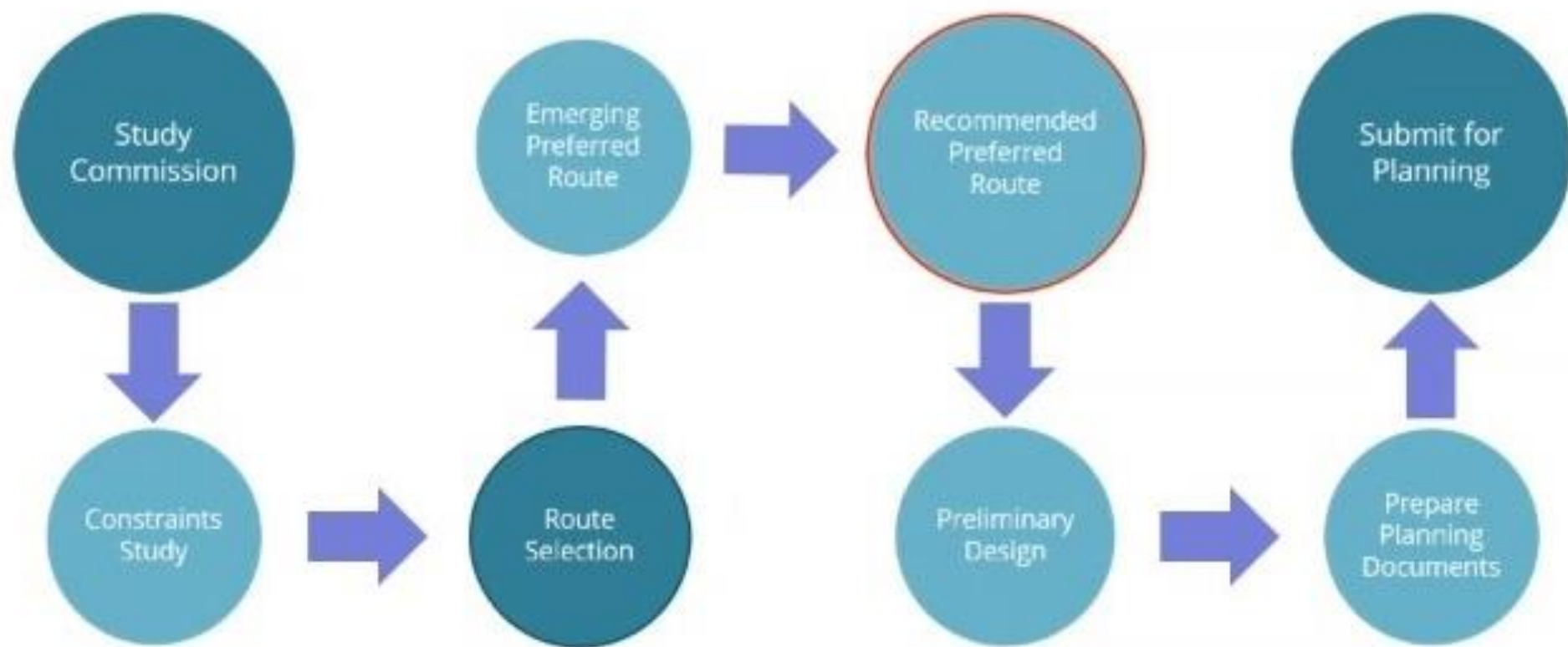
- Pedestrian & Cycle route to extend from Sutton Cross to Malahide
